SPECIAL NOTICE

TO: All Individuals Residing In The State Of California Who Purchased Health Insurance Offered By Blue Cross Of California Through Its CaliforniaCare HMO Under Contract No. 1913 Prior To June 1, 1993, Who Paid Premiums For Such Health Insurance At Any Time After June 1, 1993, And/Or Who Were Insured Under Contract No. 1913 After June 1, 1993

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED, pursuant to an order by the Superior Court of the State of California for the County of Los Angeles in connection with the settlement of the class action entitled *O'Connor, et al. v. Blue Cross of California, et al.* that:

- (1) you may be eligible to obtain health insurance through Blue Cross' CaliforniaCare HMO by enrolling under contract no. 1933;
- (2) if you are eligible to enroll under contract no. 1933, you may be able to reduce your health insurance premiums by as much as 20%;
- (3) in order to qualify for enrollment under contract no. 1933, you must fill out an application for enrollment which must be approved by Blue Cross based upon the underwriting standards applicable to contract no. 1933; and
- (4) if you are approved to enroll under contract no. 1933, you may be required to select a different primary medical group to serve you and your family.

If you are interested in applying for enrollment under contract no. 1933, please contact your local authorized Blue Cross agent or call (800) 333-0912 and request an enrollment application for the CaliforniaCare HMO under contract no. 1933.
